



### August 31, 1922 to January 6, 2012

Dr. Wendell Thomas 89, born in Gilroy CA, peacefully posed away at his home, surrounded by his loved ones. He was affectionately known by his nicknames "Wendy" and "Papa".

Dr. Thomas graduated from Loma Linda University medical school in 1948. He also served as a medical doctor in the Army, providing "Physicals" for new recruits, and was stationed in Abilene, Texas.

In 1958, Dr. Thomas moved to Son Diego and established his medical practice in La Mesa. He had many hobbies and interests, including traveling, horticulture, and building and flying model airplanes.

Three of his passions were God, family, and his career as an obstetrician and gynecologist who delivered thousands of babies at Sharp Grossmont Hospital for nearly 40 years, He loved to help people and often provided free medical care to friends and the less fortunate. He was adored and respected by his family and friends. He'll be dearly missed.

Wendy is survived b his wife Millie, and their four children Linda, Bruce, Steve and Phil. He is also survived by his eight grandchildren and five great grandchildren.
