

Model Sharing:

Ben Newkirk showed his Flyzone Calypso electric foam glider. Ben normally does not fly this type of planes, but he is planning to take a trip to Kawi, Hawaii and thought he would try some RC while there. He chose the Calypso for two reasons, it's electric and it comes apart with 2 screws. The plan is to box it up in the original box and ship it to Hawaii, fly it while he is there and then ship it back. It came with a 4 channel receiver but Ben replaced it with an 8 channel. He bought the powered glider for \$199.

Bruce Allen showed his Horizon Hobbies Apprentice S (Safe) which has a Spectrum receiver with built in stabilization. The stabilization comes in 3 modes. Mode 1 will take off and land and reduces its ability to crash. Mode 2 is the intermediate level which disables the self-centering feature. For mode 3, all bets

are off, you can do anything you wish. In any mode, if you flip the trainer switch, it will level off. The cost is \$280 which includes batteries and the transmitter. Bruce showed his second plane. The first one was flying straight and level when it pitched nose down and flew straight into the ground. He reported to Horizon Hobbies what had happened and they agreed to replace it. He still needs to send the wreck back.


electric junkies, let's keep those loose electrons picked up, eh? They get slippery if enough collect on the pavement.


