Suffice it to say that we (the Board) will do our best simply to pass information from the FAA and AMA as we receive it. We won't be setting any new club policies. In the meantime, the AMA recommends simply sitting tight and not doing anything while they continue wrestle with the FAA (most likely in court). Arthur "Mike" Aldrich 1 Sept 1926—22 Nov 2015

Mike was one of the very early members of our club—our records don't go back that far to the 1977-1978 years, but he was one of the founding members. He passed away after having heart surgery and experiencing complications. He was 89 years old.

Mike was originally from Indianapolis Indiana, coming out to San Diego when he was in the Navy and assigned to Miramar. In 1960 he went to work at US Elevator in San Diego, working there until he retired. Don and Ron with their scale projects. In the 1990's Don Gulihur's team built and raced 1/4 scle T-6's and Unlimited racers at Madera, Rialto, Rio Vista and Texas. Although Mike didn't fly these racers, he was very much a key part of the Pit Crew.

Mike was always building and flying his own models—mostly trainers. He often came out to Cactus Park with his models and had other club members fly his planes. He just had fun watching his models fly.

He often came out with his Grandson Cory, teaching him to fly RC models and just spending time with him.

Mike was very active in the club through all the years. He was almost always at the club meetings. He served as Club Treasurer for many years think for (I about 7 years) the late in 1980's into the 1990's. He didn't have a computer back then so he did it all with pencil and paper. During his



tenure as treasurer, the club invested in the first major runway resurfacing at Cactus Park. That expense was financed with contributions from club members and also having members pay two years dues up front. So Mike had a complicated accounting job as treasurer—all by hand.

Mike was close friends with Don Gulihur and Ron Smith. Mike was a builder and helped both

It is sad that such great friends—Don Gulihur, Ron Smith and now Mike Aldrich passed away in 2015. They were a team and each contributed so much over the years to our club.



Jack Hildreth 14 Nov 1932—13 Oct 2015

Jack had to drop out of the club a couple years ago due to Alzheimer's disease. He originally joined the club back in June 1989. Jack leaves his wife, June, his daughter Renee, two grandchildren and three great grand children. Jack's son Scott passed away some years ago from a traffic accident.

Jack was an active member of the club, almost always at the club meetings and a regular at the field. He was close friends with Jim Bailey and shared models with Jim.

Jack was raised in Iowa, where he built and flew U-Control models as a young boy. He came to San Diego in 1957. He worked for the San Diego Water Utilities for 29-1/2 years becoming a Supervisor in the department.

Jack kept healthy and active, walking every day. Back in 2002, Jack was honored at the Club Awards Banquet with a 12th Man Award for his service to the club

His family held private memorial services to honor Jack.
