

Old Business

Renewals – So far we have 50 out of 164 members who have renewed, we hope that will change tonight!

FAA Registration AMA recommends sUAS registration with the AMA From the AMA's Q&A page: Q: Should clubs require all members to be registered? A: No, we are not asking our clubs to police UAS Registration. That decision is up to each individual club and club leaders.

{14 CFR Part § 48.205 } "... the marking must be readily accessible and maintained in a condition that is readable and legible upon close visual inspection. Markings enclosed in a compartment, such as a battery compartment, will be considered "readily accessible" if they can be accessed without the use of tools.

Some useful notes:

You do not register each UAS (Drone, Plane, Helicopter etc) just yourself.

A copy of the certificate the FAA issues should be kept with you, in your field kit, vehicle etc.

The Board will NOT police this requirement, as per the AMA it is up to the individual.

Raffle Issue – Ted had a box that each attendee would sign a card which would be dropped into the box to be used at the Banquet to select a winner, the more meetings you attended the better chance to win. Unfortunately, in December it was discovered that at least one person had put in more than one entry into the box. (Those tickets were removed & destroyed!)

We are going back to using the Sign in book that the Secretary controls & will at the end of the year use to count up the names etc.

New Business

Sink Hole- Ted O'Fallin mentioned that a Sink Hole has appeared left hand side of the runway, which maybe in the same area when it had happened several years ago.

We've been in contact with the County Department of Public Works, and they've assessed the damage. Unfortunately, they can't do anything until they've discussed it with County Parks Department who manages the property.

Both DPW and I (Keith) have left many messages with Parks and have offered that, at a minimum, we fill the hold with dirt to at least avoid continued carnage caused by our protective barrier (see below). I hope to have a resolution this week.

We're treading a bit cautiously, primarily because we want to ensure that the environmental requirements of the retired landfill are not violated by <u>our</u> actions. Hence, we're not filling the hole until we've got confirmation from DPW that we're cleared to do so.

In the meantime, land and take off with CAUTION!

President's Message Mar 2016

Two-man "rule"

While not a rule per se, our Safety Officer Ron Keith strongly recommends (and I agree) that, when flying, we should <u>always</u> be accompanied by at least one person who's capable of making an emergency phone call on a cell phone. At any given time, an incident or injury could occur and our field is well out of the view of the public and passers-by to call for help. Safety is paramount -don't fly alone!

Sink Hole

As an update to the recorded meeting minutes, we've since been assured by the County Department of Public Works (DPW) that they will fill the sink hole. Initially, in keeping with our Reservation and Maintenance Agreement, the direction was that the club would be responsible for repairing the hole. However after review, DPW decided that it would be wise for them to excavate and fill the sink-hole to grade level. This will ensure proper controls are in place in the event that landfill debris or burn ash are encountered.

DPW is drafting a work plan that should be approved by the time you read this, followed shortly by the hole being filled.

Unfortunately, the damaged area won't be paved. We've asked DPW to top the hole with decomposed granite (DG) which should leave a solid surface and would be suited for future paving efforts.

On that **paving matter** - unfortunately we've made no ground yet within the Parks department, and have very few leads for potential charitable construction companies to have the runway professionally paved. I'm soliciting you, the members, to hunt amongst your neighbors, friends and co-workers for paving companies who may be willing to graciously contribute.

As an alternative, we may be forced to lay down a

thin slurry; a stop-gap that may only last a couple of years.

As permitted by our Bylaws, Article 3.A, and based upon Jeff's subject matter knowledge, expertise and dedication to the club, I do hereby appoint Jeff Coskey as an Electric Aircraft Safety Technician (EAST).

With that appointment, Jeff is authorized to conduct and sign for CEAP seminar completion.

That's it from my end! Goin' out to the man-cave to prep for tomorrow's flying!




