

.President's Message July 2016

Runway - She's DONE!

Only by way of monumental efforts by several of our members and financial contributions by many do we now have a beautiful, fully striped runway (one p, and one p only).

The paving effort was kicked off by Butch Wiser's motion at the April meeting. This was followed by budgetary analysis and final approval at the May meeting. One subsequent special meeting followed at which the club approved full use of the treasury with a 3-year minimum margin.

Finally on June 3rd BG Equipment laid the pavement, and on June 24th the stripes were painted.

I would like to thank Gary Rold and Dick Milhausen for overseeing the paving efforts.

Among all of those who came out to participate with the striping, I'd like to specifically thank Gary Lamb, our VP Jeff Coskey, John Irwin, Gary Rold, Don Madison and his team Fred Moffitt, Duncan Abrams and Bruce Allen.

I would specifically like to direct your attention to the superior pride and workmanship put forward by Gary Lamb and Jeff Coskey. They personally expended no less than six full work-days each cleaning, fixing, painting and striping throughout the months of May and June. Gentlemen, your work is much appreciated!! BZ!

Mid-Summer Luncheon

Don't forget the Luncheon on Saturday July 9th (flyer attached). Heck, let's get some flying done in the morning and grab some grub!

With the reduced raffle cost allowance this time around, we had some discussion about taking do-

nations for the raffle and had decided at the June meeting that we'd set up a pick-from table. If you have <u>something new</u> or in <u>excellent condition</u> that you believe other members might enjoy (and you're willing to donate), please bring it to the luncheon. We'll add it to the "pick-from" table. Please don't bring items like old fuel tanks and wheels, or your box of spare balsa. The prize donations should be of prize quality, not swap meet oriented. Ted and I will determine if a donated item might not fit the bill.

Rules and weaknesses

A few areas we need to improve on:

Frequently, members charge batteries without being in a fire-proof container. The protocol is posted on the charging tables, is in the binder in the pin box, and is on the web site.

20. Charging of Lithium Polymer (LiPo) batteries at Cactus Park shall be in accordance with the posted Weedwacker Lithium Polymer Battery Charging Protocol (and should be followed when charging batteries of any type).

And way too often, planes are flown over the runway, and in many cases violate the safety line. Note the distinction between the use of the words "should" and "shall". While it *is* permissible to fly over the runway, flight "should" be north of the runway. Please do your best to observe the guidance. The safety line, on the other hand, is a hard boundary. We "shall" not pass the safety line; flight south of the safety line is *prohibited*.

11. Flying should be confined to the area over the middle of the river flood control channel to the North, bounded by the flag/plane marker to the East, entry gate to the west and the northern runway edge to the South.

a. Other than landing or taking off, flying is prohibited south of the SAFETY LINE, situated 25 feet from the PILOT LINE.
