

Plans for the Mini-Bell are available on outer-zone.co.uk (as are hundreds of other plans). Originally designed for single channel with a Cox .020 engine or CO2 motor, they're easily converted to full-house 4-channel using an Eflite Park 180 motor.

Rules Revision Passed - Rule 11.a revision passed with 41 virtual votes cast through March 11th, all in favor, none opposed. The new rule is posted in our Safety Cabinet binder and on the websites. 
