November Meeting Election of Officers


Nomination of next year's officers is still open. If you want to be a leader of the club, this is your chance. Next year officers will be elected at this meeting and will serve starting at the December meeting.

<u>Building and Flying:</u> Lyle Black recently acquired a dozen (yes, 12) of Joe Cullum's airplane collection.

Last month he brough out the restored Waco bipe and a .25-sized fun-sport aerobat. His most recent restorations include an Ultimate biplane and a very nice scale Ryan PT-20.

The Ultimate has a YS-120 which gives him power to spare, and the bipe flies awesomely!





His re-work on attachment points of the wing and landing gear flying wires on the PT-20 was very well done. He also completely restrung the tail flying wires, repaired a crunched tailwheel assembly, and beefed up the firewall. The successful maiden on Saturday Oct 23rd was followed by many more flights the same morning. Nicely done Lyle!



1)Fetch the AED 2) Open the AED and follow the instructions.

2 towels in case the patient vomits.
