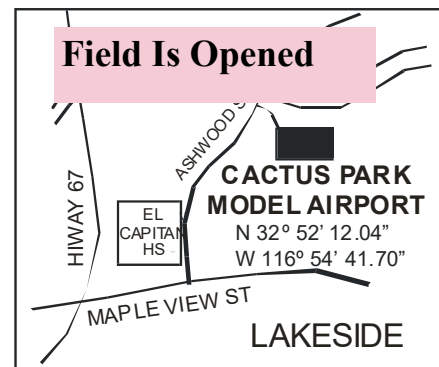

Meeting Minutes 03 June 2023

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 9:00 am at the field. Club officers present were the President, Vice President, Treasurer and the Secretary. A total of **twenty** members were present. The meeting was kicked off with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of minutes: Approval of the minutes of the May meeting was moved by Steve Shepersky, no second, approved.

Treasurers Report:

Scott temporarily lost on-line access to our account while Union Bank transitions to US Bank. The accounting here is a two-month summary but won't be reconciled until he regains account access.

Board Business: Ron asked Scott to contact Waste Management to deliver a second grey trash bin per our account agreement.

Safety Officer Report: Ron reminded members to stay hydrated and eat breakfast to stay healthy in the upcoming warm months.

Field Maintenance: There was continued discussion about trying to get volunteers to pick a day to work runway cracks and the shed roof. The issue with trying to set weekend dates is the number of conflicts with flying events. Glen Merritt moved that a specific weekday be selected and members invited to participate in the work. To that end, Wednesday June 14th was selected for runway crack filling (11 am) and shed roof work will be on Wednesday June 21st at 9am.

Rules Review: Rule #16 requires that all members wear their badges while flying at the field. Jeff (the Vice President) also reminded us that we need to avoid flying over people. This applies when vehicles are passing on the dirt road or members are in the field searching for things. Pilots must adjust their flight pattern to fly in airspace away from people.

Previous events:

Pylon Races: Glen provided a summary of the recent fun, with eight to twelve racers participating in the last few events. Our races start at 9:15 a.m. and are usually done in an hour. To promote the fun, Glen will add two "Race What You Brung" heats following our June 24th T-28 race series. All members are encouraged to bring and fly anything they want in these 10-lap heats. We can fly anything we want; trainers, warbirds, UMX, nitro, electric, gas, etc. The intent is to share the fun in racing around pylons with a group of our peers.

Fun Fly on June 10th is cancelled.
