

#### **Meeting Minutes 07 Oct 2023**

<u>Call to Order</u>: The meeting was called to order at 09:00 am at the field. Club officers present were the President, Vice President, and the Secretary. The meeting was kicked off with the Pledge of Allegiance.

<u>Approval of minutes</u>: While the prior meeting had no formal minutes, the attendees had no issues with Ron's summary as published in the Hangar News.

#### Treasurers Report:

The Treasurer was unavailable. His report was deferred to the November meeting. It was noted that there was no treasurers report included in last month's newsletter/minutes.

<u>Club Officer Elections:</u> At the time of the meeting, there were no nominations to fill the position of Secretary. The incumbent President, Vice President and Treasurer tossed their hats in for another term.

<u>November Meeting to be on Sat Oct 28<sup>th</sup></u> Due to our busy event schedule in November, the next meeting will be on the 28<sup>th</sup> at which time we hold club officer elections. If there are no contentions, incumbents and any nominees for the Secretary seat will be elected by acclamation (no vote).

<u>Safety Officer Report:</u> Ron noted that there are many squirrel holes north of the runway and to take caution so as not to twist an ankle.

#### **Field Maintenance:**

<u>Shed Roof:</u> Still incomplete, Ron asked the membership for volunteers to take charge before winter rains begin. No one at the meeting volunteered; the request is still open to the membership.

<u>Runway Maintenance:</u> A working party was planned / scheduled for Saturday October 14<sup>th</sup>. Tasks planned were to fill the cracks with sand, brush off the excess then lay beads of hot pour tar into the cracks.

<u>Rules Review</u>: When charging LiPo batteries, they must be enclosed in a LiPo sack or other fire-resistant container.

#### **Upcoming Events:**

Pylon Races at the Weedwackers is every 4<sup>th</sup> Saturday of the month. In **October**, this will be on the 28<sup>th</sup>. (SEFSD (Mission Bay) hold their every 2<sup>nd</sup> Saturday.) Since the November club meeting is also planned for October 28<sup>th</sup>, racing will occur immediately after the meeting.

Swap Meet and Toys for Tots drive: The swap meet will be held on Saturday Nov 4<sup>th</sup> at 7am. Hence the reason our November meeting is moved one week earlier. Ron moved that all Seller admission fees (\$5) will go directly to Toys for Tots. Craig Graham seconded the motion which was approved. Frank Gagliardi graciously agreed to work with Lester Moore on toys procurement.

<u>Veteran's Day Fly-In:</u> Nov 11<sup>th</sup>. Art Flores will be the Event Director. (See the attached flyer for details.) Funding for a raffle was deferred to the next club meeting (10/28). Trophies will be awarded for Best Military, Best Civilian/Sport, Best Flight Performance and Judges' Choice. Lunch will be pot luck.

<u>Annual Awards Banquet:</u> No date is set yet, and there was more discussion on venue options to reduce the impact on the club treasury. Richard Brown has been actively investigating potential venues and reporting to Ron. The intent is for an event that costs the club nothing.

<u>Fire Fighting Training:</u> Ron plans to hold a fire fighting training event in January to include use of the fire blankets that he recently added to the crash kit. He'll also demonstrate and allow members to practice attacking LiPo fires. The fire blankets he added to the crash kit are perfect for small stove/kitchen fires in the home, and Ron offered to procure blankets for any member who wants one (at member's cost).

#### **Bylaws Revisions to manage finances**



<u>Dues:</u> Dick Milhausen moved, and Lyle Black seconded a motion to raise the club dues to \$80. Keith formulated that, with the number of dues-paying members (non-youth, non-LIFE members) at around 100, this would add roughly \$400 to the club treasury each year. The members in attendance approved. [Secretary's post-meeting note: In order to comply with our bylaws and amending the bylaws, the motion must first be published in the newsletter for vote at the following club meeting. So this motion is hereby published for a vote at the October 28<sup>th</sup> meeting.]

<u>Drawings for Free Membership:</u> Richard Brown moved that the drawings pulled at each club meeting to award one-year free membership be terminated. Dick Milhausen seconded the motion. <u>Discussion In opposition:</u> One member reminded that the incentive is to encourage attendance, and that we actually award very few free memberships. Club funds can savings can be found by other methods. <u>Discussion in support:</u> Other members pointed out that the incentive was to improve meeting attendance while at Renette Park recreation center. Now that meetings are at the field on Saturdays, attendance is much improved, albeit by slightly different cadre of members. Another member opined that no one comes to meetings to win a free membership. The motion passed. [Secretary's post-meeting note: As with the dues motion above, this would be a revision to the bylaws. Hence, this motion is hereby published for a vote at the October 28<sup>th</sup> meeting.]

<u>Donations:</u> Frank Gagliardi graciously pledged a donation to the club in the amount of \$1000! Wow! Frank – the club thanks you!

Show and Tell: Ken Lawrence presented his most recent Minuette from Old School Model Works. He modified the landing gear a bit to be more like the scale bedframe gear. He also added a replica tailwheel and made the rudder full-flying. It's covered with Oratex which works beautifully around compound curves. The 3D printed replica scale motor is part of the kit. The flying wires are purely cosmetic. He uses a Cobra brushless motor. As of this meeting, the Minuette hasn't yet flown. Someone noted that the pilot looks much like our fellow member Julian!

<u>Good of the Order:</u> Frank Gagliardi mentioned that AmpDraw Hobbies in Encinitas is closing their doors on October 31s. They're selling off their entire inventory of parts, cars, planes and kits

Separately, Frank told the members that he'll be hosting yet another estate sale. The estate is currently in a storage facility near his house. Along with about ten very well-kept and bubble-wrapped models, the estate includes HAM radio gear. The event will likely be after October 21<sup>st</sup> and he'll send out notification once planned.

<u>Impromptu Auction</u>: Mel Ashdown brought out a 1400 mm foam T-28 that he generously donated to the club. While in need of some very minor hinge repair, the Club (Ron) held an impromptu auction. Julain Sonderegger won at \$50. Congrats!

The meeting adjourned at 9:44 am.
