Failure to abide by our agreement could result in the loss of use of the field so we urgently request everyone's full and continuous cooperation.


Additionally, no one other than a club officer should engage the neighbor in any way. Immediately refer any issues to Ron Keith at (619) 988-7667 for resolution.
